Phonebooks can be recycled at the following locations; Arcata Community Recycling Center, Blue Lake City Hall, Eureka Community Recycling Center, Ferndale City Barn, Fortuna City Hall, Humboldt Sanitation in McKinleyville, Rio Dell City Hall, Trinidad City Hall and in Garberville at the Redway Transfer Station.

Curbside recycling customers can place outdated phone books directly in collection bins.

Outdated phonebooks can be recycled into new phonebook pages, paper towels, toilet paper, household insulation, mulch, drywall, roofing shingles, and much more.
